#### **Greenpeace USA Organization Simulation Model**

Future University in Egypt will be the first university worldwide to launch the Greenpeace USA Model\* (GPO USA), considered as the most important organization to expose global environmental problems and promote solutions that are essential for our environment.

The Model was proposed and will be supervised by assistant professor of Political Science, Yasmine Zein Al-Abedine. Students from the six

faculties at Future University are welcome to participate on a yearly basis. The aim of the model is to Strengthen student public speaking and networking skills, and debate issues of climate change impact in all disciplines.

#### **ECONOMOS**

ECONOMOS model is one of the first educational economic models that gives value and attention to all students not only economic major students. It clarifies what happens in the real world and raises the knowledge of students about the economy. It will address the global economic challenges and how economy and investments work.
