Description :

This course develops the ability of students to integrate, analyze and interpret simulated patients' medication records information in respect to specific clinical condition. In addition, the student can develop rational drug therapy and pharmacotherapeutic care plans to provide safe and effective therapeutic monitoring and management of the diseases concerning neurological, psychiatric, endocrinological, renal, arthritic, and infectious disorders.
